## 37. Items relating to non-proliferation

## C. Non-proliferation / Democratic Republic of Korea

During the period under review, the Security Council held two meetings, half of those held in the biennium covered in the 18<sup>th</sup> Supplement. In addition, the Council adopted two resolutions, half of the total amount of decisions adopted in the previous biennium.

Council members were also briefed in consultations in March and July 2014 on the launch of various ballistic missiles by the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, in violation of relevant resolutions, as well as on the work of the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006).

The Council further extended the mandate of the Panel of Experts twice, first until 5 April 2015 and, subsequently, until 5 April 2016.<sup>2</sup>
