C. Non-proliferation/Democratic People's Republic of Korea

During the period under review, Council members held a videoconference in connection with the item entitled "Non-proliferation/Democratic People's Republic of Korea" to announce the adoption of a resolution, under Chapter VII of the Charter. ¹⁰⁷⁰ In addition, Council members held consultations of the whole and closed videoconferences in connection with this item. ¹⁰⁷¹ More information on the videoconference is given in the table below.

On 26 March 2021, the Council unanimously adopted resolution 2569 (2021). By the resolution, the Council extended the mandate of the Panel of Experts appointed pursuant to resolution 1874 (2009) in support of the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006), for a period of 12 months, until 30 April 2022. The Council requested the Panel to provide periodic reports and expressed its intent to review the Panel's mandate and to take appropriate action regarding a further extension no later than 25 March 2022, as well as to continue to follow the work of the Panel. The Council also underscored that the Panel of Experts should carry out credible, fact-based, independent assessments, analysis, and recommendations in an objective and impartial manner and in accordance with its mandate. 1072
