30. Security Council mission

During the period under review, the Security Council dispatched one mission to the field to Mali and the Niger. The mission was comprised of representatives of all members of the Council. Further to the mission, the Council held a meeting under the item entitled "Security Council mission", at which it heard briefings by the representatives of the Council co-leading the mission. More information on the meeting, including on participants and speakers, is given in the table below. ¹⁰³⁷

As reported during the briefing, Council members held in Mali meetings with the transitional Government, including the transitional President, the Prime Minister, the signatory armed groups of the Agreement on Peace and Reconciliation in Mali, representatives of civil society, the Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in Mali (MINUSMA), the United Nations country team and other individuals engaged in the international mediation. During their visit to the Niger, Council members met with the President of the Niger, the Prime Minister and the Minister for Foreign Affairs, as well as the Force Commander of the Joint Force of the Group of Five for the Sahel (G-5 Sahel) and representatives of the United Nations country team.
