SB 1114 Senator Carozza

STATE RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEM – TRANSFERS OF SERVICE

Authorizing certain members of the State Retirement and Pension System to transfer certain prior service into the State Police Retirement System.

INCOME TAX – SUBTRACTION MODIFICATION FOR DONATIONS TO DIAPER BANKS AND OTHER CHARITABLE ENTITIES – SUNSET REPEAL

Repealing certain termination provisions relating to a subtraction under the Maryland income tax for certain donations to diaper banks and other charitable entities.

SB 1116 Senator ZuckerSTATE LOTTERY FUND – BUS RAPID TRANSIT FUND DISTRIBUTION
– ALTERATIONS

Repealing a certain limitation on the distribution of up to a certain amount of money from the State Lottery Fund to the Bus Rapid Transit Fund for certain bus rapid transit system grants; and altering the circumstances for distributions from the Bus Rapid Transit Fund.

This bill requires a mandated appropriation in the annual budget bill.

SB 1117 Senator KramerEMPLOYMENT STANDARDS – FIREFIGHTERS – PAYMENT OF
OVERTIME AND PAYROLL INFORMATION

Requiring governmental units that employ firefighters to compute overtime pay in a certain manner; requiring counties and municipalities to provide certain payroll information to each firefighter employed by the county or municipality; and authorizing a firefighter or the firefighter's exclusive representative to initiate a certain grievance if a county or municipality does not provide the payroll information as required.

Preliminary analysis: local government mandate

SB 1118 Senator GuzzoneNATURAL RESOURCES – FISH AND FISHERIES – REPORTING
REQUIREMENTS

Requiring certain persons licensed or regulated by the Department of Natural Resources to submit reports in accordance with regulations adopted by the Secretary of Natural Resources.
