ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Parking Along the Big Gunpowder Falls

FOR the purpose clarifying certain circumstances under which parking may be permitted in certain areas of the Big Gunpowder Falls; and generally relating to parking.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

Section 18-2-213
Article 18 – Transportation
Title 2 – Vehicles and Traffic
Subtitle 2 – Stopping, Standing, and Parking – In General
Baltimore County Code, 2015

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County shall read as follows:

ARTICLE 18 – TRANSPORTATION

Title 2 – Vehicles and Traffic

Subtitle 2 – Stopping, Standing, and Parking – In General

§ 18-2-213. - Parking Along the Big Gunpowder Falls.

(a) A person may not park a vehicle on the roadway, shoulder area, or any grassy area abutting the road where there are posted “No Parking” signs in the following areas along the Big Gunpowder Falls:

(1) On Monkton Road between the areas of its intersection with Blue Mount Road and Manor Brook Road;

(2) On Blue Mount Road between the areas of its intersection with Monkton Road and the Torrey C. Brown Rail Trail;

(3) On Falls Road between the areas of its intersection with Monkton Road and Corbett Road;

(4) On Corbett Road between the areas of its intersection with Falls Road and Matthews Road;

(5) On Old Monkton Road West between the areas of its intersection with Monkton Road and Matthews Road; and

(6) On Notchcliff Road between the areas of its intersection with Glen Arm Road and Harford Road.

(b) (1) This section does not apply to commercial vehicles owned or operated by, or pursuant to the direction of, a public service company as that term is defined in § 1-101(x) of the

1 Public Utilities Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland if parking or standing the commercial
2 vehicle is essential to the official use then being made of the commercial vehicle.

3 (2) PARKING MAY BE PERMITTED ON PUBLIC AREAS ABUTTING THE
4 ROAD AS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A)(6) OF THIS SECTION IF THE DIRECTOR
5 OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND TRANSPORTATION DETERMINES
6 IT IS SAFE TO DO SO.

7 (c) A vehicle parked in violation of this section is punishable by a fine of \$200.

8
9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that the Baltimore County
10 Department of Public Works and Transportation shall ensure that appropriate signage is placed
11 in areas where parking is permitted as set forth in this Act.

13 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
14 the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect 14 days from the
15 date of enactment.
