AN ACT concerning

Human Relations Prohibited Practices and Human Relations Commission Procedures

FOR the purpose of clarifying the scope of the prohibition against discrimination in public accommodations; describing circumstances under which the Executive Director of the Human Relations Commission may refer a complaint to the Maryland Commission on Civil Rights or the United States Equal Employment Opportunity Commission; permitting the County Attorney to request a judicially imposed civil penalty to enforce compliance with a Human Relations Commission order; and generally related to procedures and prohibited practices under the Human Relations article.
