## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Bring Your Own Bag Act – Liquor Store Exemption

FOR the purpose of amending certain definitions to exclude liquor stores; exempting liquor stores from certain prohibitions on plastic and paper carryout bags and required fees; and generally relating to carryout bags.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

Sections 21-14-101(d)(2) and (f)(2) and 21-14-102(c) Article 21 – Permits, Licenses, and Business Regulation Title 14 – One-Time Use Plastic Carryout Bag Reduction Baltimore County Code, 2015

1	or a fuel or service station with a convenience store, or any other retail store or vendor, including
2	a temporary store or vendor at a street fair or festival.

6	§ 21-14-102. Plastic carryout bags prohibited; paper and reusable carryout bag charge.
7	(c) This section does not apply to:
8	(1) A small retail establishment; AND
9	(2) A LIQUOR STORE.
