1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE

4	§ 18-4-103. Limited Use in School Zones.
5	(A) The Police Department, in consultation with other offices and departments of the
6	county government, may develop a program for the procurement, use and implementation of
7	speed monitoring systems in school zones, in accordance with § 21-809 of the Transportation
8	Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland. The Department shall use portable speed
9	monitoring systems where feasible.
10	(B) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DEFINITION OF A "SCHOOL ZONE" SET
11	FORTH IN § 21-809(A)(7) OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE OF THE ANNOTATED
12	CODE OF MARYLAND, THE DEPARTMENT MAY USE AND IMPLEMENT SPEED
13	MONITORING SYSTEMS ON OR AROUND A DESIGNATED ROADWAY SEGMENT
14	WITHIN UP TO A HALF-MILE RADIUS OF A SCHOOL FOR ANY OF GRADES
15	KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE 12 WHERE SCHOOL-RELATED ACTIVITY
16	OCCURS, INCLUDING:
17	(1) TRAVEL BY STUDENTS TO OR FROM SCHOOL ON FOOT OR BY
18	BICYCLE; OR
19	(2) THE DROPPING OFF OR PICKING UP OF STUDENTS BY SCHOOL
20	BUSES OR OTHER VEHICLES.
21	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
22	the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect 15 days from the
23	date of its enactment.
