A. Designation of Home State - A state whose laws permit a nonresident adjuster to designate that state as its home state, the home state will require the nonresident to qualify as if the person was a resident (exam requirements and CE). The PDB and designated home state will list the record as a nonresident, designated home state.

B. Designation of Home State; CE Requirements - A state that permits a nonresident adjuster to designate that state as its home state, the home state will require and track continuing education compliance for that adjuster.
