PROCLAMATION FOR SPECIAL SESSION 2020

WHEREAS: The Ninety-First Legislature adjourned its regular session on May 17, 2020; and

WHEREAS: I called the Legislature into special sessions in June, July, August, September, and

October 2020, the Legislature adjourned those special sessions, and the Legislature is not

currently in session; and

WHEREAS: The COVID-19 pandemic continues to threaten Minnesotans and burden our State's

resources; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Constitution allows the Governor to call a special session of the

Legislature on extraordinary occasions; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 12.31, subdivision 2(b), provides that, if the Governor

determines a need to extend a peacetime emergency beyond 30 days and the Legislature is not sitting in session, the Governor must issue a call immediately convening both

houses of the Legislature; and

WHEREAS: An extraordinary occasion, as envisioned by the Minnesota Constitution, has arisen, and

it is necessary to extend the COVID-19 Peacetime Emergency originally declared on

March 13, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, by the authority vested in me by Article IV, Section 12 of the Minnesota Constitution and Sections 4.03 and 12.31 of the Minnesota Statutes, summon the members of the Legislature to convene in a Sixth Special Session on Thursday, November 12, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. at the State Capitol in Saint Paul, Minnesota.
