(1) In accordance with M.S. 474A.061, Subd 2b as amended, \$5 million is reserved for agricultural development bond loan projects of the Minnesota Rural Finance Authority; \$10 million is reserved for applications for student loan bonds of or on behalf of the Minnesota Office of Higher Education; and \$10 million each is reserved until March, May, and July for manufacturing projects.

- (2) In accordance with M.S. 474A.03, Subd. 1, 31% of the adjusted allocation in the Housing Pool -- \$64,385,194 -- is reserved until the day after the last Monday in June for single-family housing programs.
- (3) In accordance with M.S. 474A.061, Subd. 2c, \$5 million of authority in the Public Facilities Pool is reserved for 120 days (April 30) for applications of the Western Lake Superior Sanitary District.
- (4) The Unified Pool will be formed on June 28, 2022. Per M.S. 474A.091, Subd. 3(g) up to \$20 million of allocation is reserved for Manufacturing Projects.
- The following issuers received entitlement authority in 2022 pursuant to M.S. 474A: City of Saint Paul \$42,352,188; City of Minneapolis \$56,475,254; Minnesota Housing Finance Agency \$144,531,732; and Dakota County \$28,246,136.
