



## Legislative Advisory Commission 10-day Federal Coronavirus Relief Fund Review Order

On July 28, 2020, legislators were briefed on the details of federal Coronavirus Relief Fund requests #48 through #53 by the At-Risk Populations Work Group Leads Cathy ten Broeke and Dan Pollock. The briefing invitations were provided to the ten members of the Legislative COVID-19 Response Commission and the Committee Chairs for the relevant legislative committees for the Legislative Advisory Commission.

On July 29, 2020, these requests were submitted for review to the Legislative Advisory Commission under the provisions in Minnesota Statute 3.3005, subdivision 4 and 5. The requests are approved.
