Subject: URGENT REVIEW | #29 Coronavirus Relief Fund Request to Legislative Advisory Commission

This is a request to spend federal dollars received through the CARES Act as part of the Coronavirus Relief Fund for necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID–19). This request is submitted under M.S. 3.3005 subd. 4 and 5, which allows for a 10-day review.

Also, excluded are any COVID-19 related expenditures paid from COVID-related federal/state funds already awarded to DEED. We are using these resources first to preserve the more flexible CRF dollars. This exclusion includes our payroll (C19 and CVD) and non-payroll expenses for our Unemployment Insurance Program. These UI COVID-19 expenses certainly meet the requirements for reimbursement under this CRF program, but we received \$9.8 million in administrative dollars from the Department of Labor for their COVID-related expenses, exclusively for the operation of this program. Similarly, we have excluded BCD payroll expenses (C19 only) since they received state dollars and we have used other BCD funding sources for these COVID-19 related expenses since there were no administrative dollars provided.

## **CRF Fund Request Confirmations**

- Confirm that your CRF funding request meets federal guidance: (1) as a necessary expenditure to respond to the COVID-19 public health emergency, (2) is not accounted in the current biennial budget and (3) funds will be expended by December 30, 2020.

  - Damages covered by insurance
  - Payroll or benefits of employees whose work duties are not substantially dedicated to mitigating or responding to COVID-19
  - Costs reimbursed under other federal programs or funding sources
  - Reimbursement to donors for donated items or services
  - Workforce bonuses other than hazard pay or overtime
  - Severance pay
  - Government revenue replacement, including provision of assistance to individuals or businesses to meet tax obligations
