

Standard Look Back

The Standard Look Back process is used to measure the hours worked by Ongoing Employees. The purpose of measuring employees is to identify those that are full time and must be offered medical coverage according to the Affordable Care Act rules. Ongoing Employees includes any employee employed by any branch of state government on the first day of the Standard Measurement Period.

The Standard Administrative Period is the period of time that Agencies must review the hours worked by all employees in each year as indicated below. An employee is measured as full time if they work on average 30 or more hours per week throughout the Standard Measurement Period. Employees found to be full time during the Standard Measurement Period are eligible for coverage throughout the associated Standard Stability Period.

Remember, not all employees are included in the Standard Look Back, it is only those who were employed in any branch of state government on the first day of the Standard Measurement Period. Any employee not included in the Standard Look Back is in an Initial Measurement Period.

This table defines Standard Look Backs for the Executive branch, the Judicial Branch, Minn State, and any state agency following the Executive branch's pay periods. Each row represents one Standard Look Back period.
