*A Resolution adding Juneteenth as a County Holiday*

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners has the authority to modify the Asotin County Personnel Manual as needed; and

**WHEREAS**, RCW 1.16.050 declares state legal holidays and was amended on July 25, 2021 by SHB 1061 to include Juneteenth.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Asotin County Commissioners that section 6.6 of the Personnel Manual be amended to add the Juneteenth (June 19<sup>th</sup>) holiday.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that effective immediately, June 19<sup>th</sup> will be a paid holiday for regular full-time and part-time employees in accordance with the Personnel Manual.


