**RESOLUTION NO. 1042**

**A RESOLUTION** of the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District, No. 90, King County, Washington, declaring as surplus wood removed from various property/easements of the District, and authorizing public or private sale.

**WHEREAS**, the District performed property and easement maintenance that included the removal of some trees; and


**WHEREAS**, the resulting wood has a value of less than \$2,500.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That the wood is hereby declared to be surplus and has a value of less than \$2,500.00.

**SECTION 2:** That in accordance with RCW 57.08.015, the District may dispose of the wood at public or private sale. Given that the wood may have no value, or that the time and cost of sale could exceed any value, District staff may cause the wood to be disposed of by the most cost effective means.
