Noise Variance Application

(Pullman City Code Chapter 8.80)



Per Pullman City Code, Chapter 8.80, public disturbance noise is prohibited as a public nuisance. It is unlawful for any person to cause or permit any disturbance noise, or for any person in possession or control of real or personal property to cause or permit to originate from such property any public disturbance noise. Electronically amplified noise is regulated 24-hours a day, and all noise is regulated between 10:00pm and 7:00am, including unamplified voices. Any person, company, or organization wishing to request a noise variance for a specific event shall apply in writing to the Chief of Police. Upon review, the Chief of Police or designee may grant a noise variance, if it is determined that the variance is in the public interest and that the proposed activity will have a substantial public participation. Violation of this chapter of City Code can result in a civil infraction and a monetary fine.
