## ALSO SUBMIT WITH THIS COMPLETED APPLICATION FORM:

- 1) An accurate area map showing the location of proposed and existing (if any) telecommunications facilities in the City that the applicant intends to use.
- 2) The location proposed for new ducts, conduits, or poles, and evidence that there is sufficient capacity within the public ways for the proposed telecommunications facilities. *Note: Applicants*

- seeking to install new poles must follow the procedures outlined in the municipal code. Applicant should not presume that requests to install new poles will be approved.
- 3) Evidence of registration in the one-number locator service, as described in RCW Chapter 19.122.
- 4) Proof of agency, if necessary (as indicated above).
- 5) Provide a copy of the Utilities and Transportation Commission Registration and Competitive Classification of Telecommunications Companies form, if you are registered with the Utilities and Transportation Commission.
- 6) Provide the most recent income statement or report of gross revenues used for calculating utility taxes paid to the City. This report should contain detailed information as to how you calculated the utility taxes owed to the City.
- 7) An 11"x17" set of preliminary engineering plans, specifications, and a map with sufficient detail to identify the following items:
  - a. The location and route requested for the applicant's proposed telecommunications facilities;
  - b. The location of applicant's overhead and underground public utility, telecommunication, cable, water, sewer drainage and other lines and equipment in the public ways along the proposed route;
  - c. The specific trees, structures, improvements, facilities, lines and equipment and obstructions, if any, that applicant proposes to temporarily or permanently remove or relocate;
- 8) A preliminary construction schedule and completion date.
- 9) Complete submittals of any other necessary environmental or construction permits including, but not limited to, shorelines, SEPA, etc.
- 10) Evidence that zoning and land use permits have been obtained from the City, or that applications for such permits and approvals have been submitted to the City and that the proposed telecommunications facility meets all applicable zoning and land use codes.
- 11) A photo simulation of the proposed above ground facilities.
- 12) A completed Telecommunications Special Use Wireless Application form as available from the City of Mountlake Terrace. (This form is not required if the proposed telecommunication facility is exempt from the standards of MTMC Chapter 19.137)
