	authority on all leave requests.

Traveling outside the City of Berkeley without a written permission from the program is prohibited and will result in serious disciplinary actions and/or dismissal from the program. Leaving campus without obtaining permission of the RAM is prohibited and will result in serious disciplinary actions and/or dismissal from the program. Leaving program accommodation after curfew without the explicit permission of program staff is prohibited and will result in serious disciplinary actions and/or dismissal from the program. The use of rideshare services including but not limited to conventional taxis, Uber, and Lyft is prohibited and will result in serious disciplinary actions and/or dismissal from the program. The use of electric scooters, or bike services including but not limited to Lime, Bird, and Citi Bike is prohibited and will result in serious disciplinary actions and/or dismissal from the program. Tampering with fire safety equipment, removal of furniture from common areas, hanging or throwing things out the windows, damaging walls, furniture, or vending machines will result in serious disciplinary actions and/or dismissal from the program. Fighting, stealing, vandalism or loud noises will result in serious disciplinary actions and/or dismissal from the program. Possession or use of weapons will result in serious disciplinary actions and/or dismissal from the program.
