STATUS REPORT

Litigation pursuant to the Protehi I Hanom Act of 2019 U.S. District Court of South Carolina Case No. 19-CV-03602 Multidistrict Litigation No. 2873

October 28, 2020

I. Additional defendants have been added to the OAG's MDL PFAS Litigation

The Office of the Attorney General (OAG) has filed its First Amended Complaint (19-CV-03602) in the United States District Court for the District Court of South Carolina, Charleston Division, adding additional defendants to its Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) lawsuit.

The OAG sued eight companies last year alleging that they engaged in false, misleading and deceptive acts about the risks posed by their products. In its First Amended Complaint, the OAG added Arkema Inc.; AGC Chemicals, Americas, Inc.; Dynax Corporation; Clariant Corporation DuPont De Nemours, Inc.; and Corteve, Inc., to the list of liable manufacturers, alongside The 3M Company, Tyco Fire Products LP, Chemguard Inc., Buckeye Fire Equipment Company, Kidde-Fenwal Inc., National Foam Inc., E.I. Du Point De Nemours and Co., and The Chemours Company.
