This information is <u>not</u> meant as a substitute to contacting the Parole Commission. It is meant to provide brief information of the Pardon process, in order to assist you, in determining if a pardon request may be appropriate for you.

Requirements:

- 1. Application 26 pages
- 2. Each Section must be completed
- 3. The application must be signed and notarized
- 4. Three (3) character letters
- 5. Copy of photo identification
- 6. Copy of birth certificate
- 7. Certified copy of driving record, from every state in which you had a driver's license
- 8. Certified copy of criminal record
- 9. Copy of educational diploma(s) high school, college, training school, etc.
- 10. If applicable, copy of your military separation paper
- 11. If applicable, copy of a court-martial conviction

Eligibility:

- 1. Cannot be currently incarcerated or on probation/parole.
- 2. Misdemeanants must be crime-free for 5 years from the latest date of end of probation or parole, release from incarceration, or date of sentence.
- 3. Felons must be crime-free for 10 years from the latest date of end of probation or parole, release from incarceration, or date of sentence.
- 4. Felons/Crimes of Violence and Felony Drug Conviction must be crime-free for 20 years from the latest date of end of probation or parole, release from incarceration, or date of sentence.

Factors

- * The nature and circumstances of the crime
- * The effect of the pardon on the victim and the community
- * The sentence given
- Anti-social behavior of the applicant
- * Subsequent rehabilitation of the applicant
- The reason the pardon is requested
