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Executive Summary

The Speed Camera Program started in Philadelphia in June 2020 along Roosevelt Boulevard (Route 1) corridor and continues to demonstrate its impact on driver and traffic safety. Data has consistently shown that vehicles are slowing down at the locations where speed cameras are installed and violations issued have continued to decrease, even at the new locations that were installed June of 2022.

Recently the Pennsylvania State Transportation Advisory Committee released an evaluation of the speed program that is installed in the city of Philadelphia. Not only did the Speed Camera Program reduce speeding along the corridor, but it reduced crashes where in other parts of the city they only slightly decreased. According to the report, using summary data from 2019 and 2021, total crashes declined on the Boulevard by 36%, whereas the rest of the city they only declined by 6%. The Committee stated that the program should remain and be further expanded to other municipalities throughout the State. Another recommendation is the changing of the state report due date. This will enable the Parking Authority to submit more complete data and audited financials to the state.

The sunset time of the Speed program is quickly approaching and, with documented evidence that this program has had a positive effect on reducing dangerous speeding along Roosevelt Boulevard, it is more important than ever that the pilot program be extended or made permanent. This program, with other improvements that will be coming to the Roosevelt Boulevard corridor will continue to make the area safer for the families, commuters, and citizens that reside along this roadway.

The Philadelphia Parking Authority, collaborating with the Mayors Vision Zero program and the Office of Transportation Innovation and Sustainability are committed to keeping the Boulevard and the City of Philadelphia safer, for not just drivers, but for residents who choose to walk or ride their bikes throughout the City.

Issuance and Comparison

Violations have continued to decline since the start of the program. In June of 2022, two new speed camera locations were installed, increasing the number of cameras operating on the Boulevard from thirty-two to forty. This created a spike in the number of violations, though numbers went down after the warning period ended for the two new sites.

Since the program has been operating for a longer period, it is now possible to do a full year by year comparison to further show how driving behavior has changed on the Boulevard. From June 2020 to November 2022, violations have fallen 88.5%, and continue to decline. This is not as low as the percentages shown in prior reports, due to the installation of the eight additional cameras.

Please note, in all data sets, due to the statute of limitations and events still being processed there could be changes to the number of violations issued, and issuance speed for December 2022, January 2023, and February 2023. These numbers will be indicated with an asterisk. All data below is as of February 28th, 2023.


If we remove the additional camera data, the locations since June 2020 have declined 95.3% as of November 2022.

Speed camera violations on the Roosevelt Boulevard have remained consistent. While there was an increase in violations that occurred around the time when the two newest locations were installed in June 2022, the total number of violations have not reached the level that the program saw when the speed camera program was initially implemented, showing that the cameras are still effective in slowing down drivers. We anticipate that over the next year violations should decrease, which is what we observed with the other locations that were installed in June of 2020.

The majority of violators still are within the lowest level where violations are issued, 11-19 MPH. There has been an increase in the number of violations that are at the higher levels. Again, this could be due to the two new locations that were installed in June of 2022.

Collection of Revenue and Hearing Requests

Collection of fines has been consistent. As the citation ages, additional notices are issued to the citizen with the addition of late fees. The citation is then assigned to debt collections, where further contact with the citizen is made to collect on the outstanding debt. In addition to notices, if a violation remains in an unpaid status, the plate has the potential in being placed in boot eligibility status if the vehicle has three or more unpaid parking, red light or speed violations. Data reflects numbers as of February 28th, 2023.

Speed Funding of Safety Project Initiatives

On January 6th, 2023, Governor Wolf announced the programs that would be awarded funding that was generated from the Speed Camera Programs. The Roosevelt Boulevard will benefit from this grant money, with \$13 million being used to help further safety improvements. The following are the awarded grant projects:

- \$10 million for the design of intersection modifications related to the Roosevelt Boulevard Route for Change program in the City of Philadelphia. These modifications include curb extensions to shorten pedestrian crossing distances, realigned crosswalks, realigned lane configurations and turn lanes, upgrades to traffic signals and timing, changes to traffic movements, and new or upgraded transit shelters and stations.
- \$1.5 million for the Roosevelt Boulevard Parallel Corridor Intelligent Transportation Systems
 (ITS) and Emergency Preemption Program which includes design and construction of emergency
 preemption along corridors as well as make-ready signal upgrades needed for the introduction
 of red-light running cameras by Philadelphia Parking Authority (PPA) at select intersections on
 Roosevelt Boulevard corridors in the City of Philadelphia.
- \$1.5 million for Roosevelt Boulevard to support 2040 alternatives analysis for Roosevelt Boulevard improvements, in compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). It will also advance environmental analysis, preliminary engineering, and design 2025 Improvements identified in the Route for Change report.
- \$1.5 million for Signal Integration & ITS to continue to expand and upgrade several arterials with state-of-the-art technology by integrating them into an advanced traffic management system (ATMS).

Improving the Boulevard

The Roosevelt Boulevard is a diverse roadway. It is a place where people reside and shop, and a corridor where commuters travel that connects the northeast section of the city, and surrounding counties, with the rest of Philadelphia. The speed cameras have helped make this roadway safer to travel and safer live. On January 4, 2023, Senator Bob Casey had announced that the city would receive \$78 million in U.S. Department of Transportation Funding for further safety improvements. This will include improving the medians, crosswalks, traffic signal upgrades, business access and transit lanes (https://www.casey.senate.gov/news/releases/casey-announces-78-million-for-philadelphias-roosevelt-boulevard).

These upgrades, along with the Automated Speed Camera (ASE)Grant Program funding, and funding that was award from the Automated Red Light Camera (ARLE) Grant Program will help pedestrians navigate the roadway with improved intersections, commuters with improved traffic signals that are integrated, and designated bus lanes to help move along public transit without delays.

Crash Data

The Pennsylvania State Transportation Advisory Commission report indicates the different impacts the cameras have had along the Boulevard. In the report, it states that compared with the rest of the city, total crashes have declined 36%, where in the rest of the city it only decreased to 6% from 2019 to 2021. Also noted in the report, crashes are less severe along the Boulevard, which could be due to the reduced speeds. On page seventeen of the report, it states that "speeding related crashes have dropped 17% along the Boulevard, whereas other areas they have risen across Philadelphia." Vehicles with Covered or No Plates Impeding Enforcement

The Authority currently manages the Automated Red Light Camera Enforcement Program (ARLE) and the Automated Speed Camera Enforcement Program (ASE) in the City of Philadelphia. Legislation for the Red Light Camera Enforcement Program allows for installation throughout the entire City. Legislation for the Speed Camera Program limits the program to only allow installation on the Route 1 (Roosevelt Boulevard) corridor.

As you are aware, the program is designed for all violations to be reviewed by Authority staff before being sent for final approval from the Philadelphia Police Department. Incomplete registration information prohibits the issuance of a violation.

"Plate/Vehicle Obstructed", "Unreadable Plate" and "No Plate" are some of the reject codes that are often used by the Red Light and Speed Camera staff when reviewing potential violations. These reject codes are deemed uncontrollable rejections-- meaning the violation, while otherwise valid, has been invalidated due to driver behavior (covering or removing the plate) that is deemed out of our control. Uncontrollable rejections are concerning to the Authority since they lend to additional unsafe driver behavior.

Below you will find data for the time period of March 1, 2022, to February 28, 2023 displaying the driving behavior, I reference.

Automated Red-Light Camera Program

Automated Speed Camera Program

Total Violations (1 Vendor, Conduent) 429,375

There are thirty-four thousand nine hundred and five (34,905) violations that cannot be processed due to this rejection code. In other words, approximately 2.04% of violators refrain from properly displaying their license plate while operating their vehicle, as required by law.

The data also notes that the rate of vehicles operating with no plate while speeding is significantly higher than the rate of red-light violators operating their vehicle with no plate. While we are unable to offer a definitive explanation for this discrepancy, the Authority feels that it is imperative to highlight this trend, particularly if the speed camera program is made permanent and extended throughout the city.

It was also noted that .78% (240) or slightly lower than one percent, of the vehicles observed speeding without a license plate were clocked at a speed in excess of 100 mph.

Location Analysis

Two new locations, 700 W. Roosevelt and 5000 Roosevelt were installed in June of 2022. Total warnings that were issued for these locations in June of 2022 was 32,851. By November 2022, violations that were issued from these locations fell to 15,240. This is a decrease of 53.61%. The locations that were installed in June of 2020 saw an 82.76% decrease for the same time period in 2020. Though the decrease is not as dramatic, it still demonstrates that the program is effective in changing driving behavior.

Overall, the numbers have started to show some consistency which can be expected for a program that has been in effect for a period of time. With increased police presence and increased safety measures installed along the Boulevard, cameras will continue to help the Boulevard become a safer road to travel.

Data per camera is shown Appendix A. December, January, and February of 2021 were included in the tables since the full data was not included with last year's report. Please note, in all data sets, due to the statute of limitations and events still being processed in the program, there could be changes to the number of violations issued, and issuance speed for December 2022, January 2023, and February 2023. These numbers will be indicated with an asterisk. All data is as of February 28th, 2023.
