

PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT WAGER

The Progressive Jackpot Wager is an optional \$5 side bet that must be made prior to the delivery of any cards. To begin each round, players must make two equal wagers called the ante and the blind bonus and if they desire to bet the progressive wager, they may do so by placing a \$5 chip on the red progressive sensor in front of their betting position. The sensor will illuminate to indicate the wager has been accepted. The progressive bet considers the best hand possible among the player's two hole cards and the first three community cards (flop), to make a 5-card poker hand, in addition, you become eligible for The Must Hit By Jackpot (MHB), sometimes referred to as a Mystery Jackpot which is configured in addition to the traditional progressive. Folded hands do not qualify for "hand-based" progressive payouts, but you may still qualify for an envy bonus, and you may win the Must Hit By Jackpot. If another player at the table hits a hand associated with an envy pay, all other players who made the progressive side bet win the envy pay. The MHB* has a configuration set between two values, the reset amount and the MHB amount. Using a random number generator, a random value is chosen between the two values that will become the jackpot-winning amount. Each player's progressive wager contributes a small amount to the MHB Jackpot. Once the accumulation of wagers puts the Jackpot over the winning amount, a random guest who wagered on the progressive will be awarded the MHB jackpot.

Original Wager is not returned.
\$50,000 maximum payout per player per hand does not apply to progressive payouts and does not apply to the trips wager.

Ultimate Texas Hold'em is an exciting game based on the version of Poker known as Texas Hold'em. The game also features an optional progressive side bet for a higher payout.

HOW TO PLAY

Before any cards are dealt, the Player must make two equal wagers called the Ante and the Blind Bonus. Each Player and the Dealer will then be dealt two cards face down. The Player will then have the option to either bet three or four times the Ante as a Raise bet, or he/she may 'Check' and do nothing. The Dealer will then turn over three community cards. At this point, any Player who has already 'Raised' may not bet again. If the Player 'Checked', he/she will have the option to bet two times his/her Ante as a Raise bet or again, he/she may Check. The Dealer will then turn over the final two community cards. Any Player who has already Raised (4 times or 2 times) may not bet again. All other Players must now either bet one times his/her Ante as a Raise bet or he/she must Fold, forfeiting all his/her Ante and Blind Bonus wager.

Each Player and the Dealer are trying to make the best possible 5-card Poker hand using their initial 2-card deal, plus the 5 community cards. The Player or Dealer may use 3, 4 or all 5 of the community cards to make his/her hand. If the Dealer's hand outranks the Player's hand, the Player loses his/her Blind Bonus and Raise wagers.

If the Dealer's hand does not contain at least a Pair, he/she does not qualify and the Ante wager is a push. If the Dealer qualifies, the Player loses the Ante wager as well.

If the Dealer's hand and the Player's hand tie, all wagers push.

If the Player's hand outranks the Dealer's hand, the Player will be paid as follows:

Ante Wager - If the Dealer has at least a Pair, the Player will be paid even money on this wager. If the Dealer does not have a pair, this bet pushes.

Raise Wager - The Player will be paid even money.

BLIND BONUS WAGER

Blind Bonus Wager - If the Player wins with a Three of a Kind or less, this wager pushes. If the Player wins with a Straight or better, he/she will be paid according to the following payable.

Royal Flush	500 to 1
Straight Flush	50 to 1
Four of a Kind	10 to 1
Full House	3 to 1
Flush	3 to 2
Straight	1 to 1

OPTIONAL TRIPS WAGER

The Optional Trips Wager must be placed prior to any cards being dealt. The Player is competing against the payable regardless of the outcome of his/her hand against the Dealer's hand. The Player will be paid according to his/her final hand, regardless of how the Dealer does, and regardless of when he/she Raises or if he/she Folds.

Straight Flush	40 to 1
Four of a Kind	20 to 1
Full House	7 to 1
Flush	6 to 1
