

# ROYAL FLUSH PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT RULES

## QUALIFYING GAMES:

All No Limit Hold'em cash games with a bad beat rake taken will be eligible for the Bad Beat Jackpot. In these games, we will collect \$1.00 from each pot which reaches \$10 and an additional \$1.00 when the pot reaches \$30. Players on No Limit games not opened as eligible games may request to be bad beat eligible and will be upon the first hand when a contribution is taken from the pot for the Bad Beat Jackpot.

## QUALIFIED PLAYER:

A player must maintain an active hand at that table during the hand when the jackpot was hit in order to be a participant in the Royal Flush Jackpot payout. The player must have two (2) cards held used to complete a Royal Flush when combined with three (3) community cards. The hand must be dealt to conclusion and the Royal Flush must be shown at showdown even if the opposing player(s) fold without showing their hand(s).

## QUALIFIERS FOR JACKPOT:

The Royal Flush Jackpot will apply to No Limit Hold'em cash games exclusively. The qualifier for the jackpot is a Royal Flush which will be paid according to the amount in the suit of which the Royal Flush belongs. To qualify, the winning hand must use both of their hole cards to make the Royal Flush. To qualify for any jackpot there must be a minimum of four (4) players dealt cards, there must be a minimum pot size of \$10.

## QUALIFIERS FOR ONE CARD ROYAL:

When a Royal Flush in any suit reaches \$1000 players may use one of the cards in their hand to make a Royal Flush to win 10% of that particular Royal Flush Jackpot. Ex. Spade Royal Flush is \$5000 a player has a Royal Flush using only one of the cards in their hand, the player will receive \$500 and the Spade Royal fund will be adjusted to \$4500.

## DISQUALIFIERS:

Additional disqualifiers include fouled decks, collusion and failure to collect the jackpot contribution. If in the opinion of management any player passes any inappropriate information to another during the hand in order to influence the action, the jackpot will be disqualified. In all such disputes, management decisions will be final. If more than one game in the room hits the jackpot at the exact same time, the main jackpot amount and the additional \$50 will be split equally between the players.

## PRIZE DISTRIBUTION:

When the jackpot is hit, the current day's posted Royal Flush Jackpot amount for that suit will be paid and the jackpot will be reset to \$0. \$50 will be the minimum amount paid to the player by Rivers Casino Poker Room.

Note: Players may not receive both a Royal Flush Jackpot and a Bad Beat Jackpot in the same hand. If a Royal Flush is part of the Bad Beat they will receive only the Bad Beat payout.
