PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT WAGER


The Progressive Jackpot Wager is an optional \$5 side bet that must be made prior to the delivery of any cards. To begin each round, players must make an ante bet and if they desire to bet the progressive wager, they may do so by placing a \$5 chip on the red progressive sensor in front of their betting position. The sensor will illuminate to indicate the wager has been accepted. The progressive bet considers the best hand possible among all five cards dealt to the player, in addition, you become eligible for The Must Hit By Jackpot (MHB), sometimes referred to as a Mystery Jackpot which is configured in addition to the traditional progressive. Folded hands do not qualify for "hand-based" progressive payouts, but you may still qualify for an envy bonus, and you may win the Must Hit By Jackpot. If another player at the table hits a hand associated with an envy pay, all other players who made the progressive side bet win the envy pay. The MHB* has a configuration set between two values, the reset amount and the MHB amount. A random value is chosen between the two that will become the jackpot-winning amount. Each player's progressive wager contributes a small amount to the MHB Jackpot. Once the accumulation of wagers puts the Jackpot over the winning amount, a random guest who wagered on the progressive will be awarded the MHB jackpot.

4 CARD POKER

RULES AND REGULATIONS

In Four Card Poker, the player can compete against the dealer by making an Ante wager, the pay table by making an Aces Up™ wager, or both the dealer and the pay table by making the Ante wager and the Aces Up™ wager. Players receive five cards to make their best four card hand and the dealers receives six cards to make their four card hand. The dealer always qualifies.

After reviewing their hands, players may fold or make the Play wager which can be one to three times their Ante. If a player's hand beats or ties the dealer, their Play and Ante wagers win even money. If the dealer's hand beats a player's hand, the player loses both wagers.

The Aces Up™ bonus bet wins when players have a pair of Aces or better, and wins regardless of whether players win or lose to the dealer. If players have a premium hand of a 3-of-a-Kind or higher, they win an automatic bonus on their Ante wager. Automatic bonuses always win, even when players lose to the dealer.
