

PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT WAGER

The Progressive Jackpot Wager is an optional \$5 side bet that must be made prior to the delivery of any cards. To begin each round, players must make an ante wager and if they desire to bet the progressive wager, they may do so by placing a \$5 chip on the red progressive sensor in front of their betting position. The sensor will illuminate to indicate the wager has been accepted. The progressive bet considers the best hand possible among the player's two cards and the three community cards, in addition, you become eligible for The Must Hit By Jackpot (MHB), sometimes referred to as a Mystery Jackpot which is configured in addition to the traditional progressive. Folded hands do not qualify for "hand-based" progressive payouts, but you may still qualify for an envy bonus, and you may win the Must Hit By Jackpot. If another player at the table hits a hand associated with an envy pay, all other players who made the progressive side bet win the envy pay. The MHB* has a configuration set between two values, the reset amount and the MHB amount. A random value is chosen between the two that will become the jackpot-winning amount. Each player's progressive wager contributes a small amount to the MHB Jackpot. Once the accumulation of wagers puts the Jackpot over the winning amount, a random guest who wagered on the progressive will be awarded the MHB jackpot.

MISSISSIPPI STUD POKER

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Mississippi Stud is a 5 card poker game that lets you bet up to 10 units on a single hand. Mississippi Stud allows players to compete against a pay table rather than the dealer, and win if their hand is a pair of J's or better.

HAND	PAYOUT
Royal Flush	500 to 1
Straight Flush	100 to 1
4-of-a-Kind	40 to 1
Full House	10 to 1
Flush	6 to 1
Straight	4 to 1
3-of-a-Kind	3 to 1
2 Pair	2 to 1
Pair of Jacks or Better	1 to 1
Pair of 6s to 10s	Push

To play, players make an Ante bet to receive their first two cards. The dealer will place three community cards face down in the middle of the layout.

Once they receive their cards, players may either fold or make the 3rd Street bet of one to three times their Ante. The dealer will then reveal the first community card, and players may either fold or make the 4th Street bet of one to three times their Ante. The dealer will then reveal the second community card, and players can either fold or stay in the game by making the 5th Street bet from one to three times their Ante.

After the dealer turns over the final community card, he resolves all bets left in action. Players win if their 5 card hand contains a pair of J's or better. If a player folds they forfeit all of their bets that are still left in action.

3 CARD BONUS™ OPTIONAL SIDE BET

You may make the optional 3 Card Bonus™ bet in addition to your standard Mississippi stud wager. At the casino's discretion, you may bet more on this bonus than on the three community cards. If the three community cards contain a pair or better, your 3 Card Bonus™ bet wins. See pay table:
