

YARD SALE ORDINANCE

REGULATIONS FOR UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY

This fact sheet provides essential information on the standards for garage sales, yard sales, or similar events in residential areas.

WHO CAN CONDUCT YARD SALES?

Only the property owners, or residents of the dwelling unit where the sale is taking place, can conduct yard sales.

WHAT CAN BE SOLD AT YARD SALES?

You can only sell secondhand, household, or incidental personal items. Sale of new retail merchandise, food, or drinks is prohibited.

WHEN CAN YARD SALES BE CONDUCTED?

DESIGNATED WEEKENDS	Last full weekend of every month. Allowed 7am - 6pm. No registration / fee required.
OTHER WEEKENDS	Up to 2 additional weekends allowed per year. Allowed 7am-6pm. Registration and fee payment required.
MONDAY - FRIDAY	Yard sales are not allowed.

Operators found in violation of these standards will be cited and may be subject to non-compliance fees and other penalties.

WHERE CAN YARD SALES BE CONDUCTED?

You may conduct a yard sale at any residence in the unincorporated areas of LA County. You can only place items within the front or side yards. Signage and items are prohibited in the public sidewalk, parkway, street, or alley. You may place 2 signs, up to 4 square feet each, within the front or side yards.
