Tips for Declared Counties (Tier 1 & 2)

- Determine which projects from your Local Mitigation Strategy (LMS) project list you will submit based on your allocation.
- Prioritize the selected projects in the order that you want them funded. Projects may be ordered differently than they are in the LMS project list.
- If possible, over-submit for your allocation.
- Begin/Complete the applications for your selected projects.
- Complete the application checklist to ensure nothing has been overlooked or left out.
- Ask questions. Ask often.

Tips for Un-declared Counties (Tier 3)

- Determine which projects from your Local Mitigation Strategy (LMS) project list you will submit based on your allocation.
- Project prioritization is not required for Tier 3, however any project submitted must be endorsed by the Chairperson/Vice-Chairperson of your LMS Working Group.
- If possible, submit as many projects as you can as early as you can.
- Begin/Complete the applications for your selected projects.
- Complete the application checklist to ensure nothing has been overlooked or left out.
- Ask questions. Ask often.

If needed, the State will review draft Scopes of Work prior to submittal.

Any eligible applicant seeking HMGP funding must submit within the open application window, regardless of tier.

Sub-recipient submits completed applications to the State for review. Review includes:

- Technical feasibility
- Environmental soundness
- Cost-effectiveness
- Floodplain management compliance

The State submits projects to FEMA for approval.

FEMA reviews and issues award letters for approved projects.

The State begins the contracting phase with the sub-recipient.
