- Leverage experiences and knowledge gained over three years
- Adhere to statutory requirements
- Provide two-way communication

# PROJECT APPROACH (CONT'D)

- Use a local system integrator (SI): OSaaS selected in competitive bid
- Build the new CAL-ACCESS in an iterative fashion (Agile)
- Base construction on requirements
- Use Subject Matter Experts and engage external stakeholders



#### PHASED IMPLEMENTATION

### The CARS Project is utilizing a phased implementation approach.

- ➤ Release I February 28: Implement the majority of functionality; select internal Secretary of State users and select external stakeholders will have access for stabilization and validation
- ➤ Release 2 April 30: Implement correspondence, financial transactions, API initial filings, E530 and more
- ➤ Release 3 June 30: Public access, system certification by the Secretary, and retirement of the legacy CAL-ACCESS



#### PHASED IMPLEMENTATION – THREE RELEASES

#### **RELEASE I**

- Automated Functionality
  - √ Filer Disclosures
  - ✓ Filer Registration
  - ✓ Correspondence
  - ✓ Financial Transactions
  - ✓ System Reports
- Data Retrieval / Queries
- System Administration (account maintenance., user notifications, etc.)

#### **RELEASE 2**

- Software Fixes
- Non-Automated Functionality
  - ✓ SOS User Notes and Add'l. Correspondence
  - ✓ Additional Financial Transactions
- Migrated Data and Additional Data Retrieval
- Additional System Admin. / System Notifications

- Software Fixes
- Final Data Migration
- Public Data Portal / Search
- API (Software Vendor Interface)
- SOS User Training
- Public User Instructional Materials
- System Certification
- Retirement of the legacy CAL-ACCESS




#### BENEFITS OF A PHASED IMPLEMENTATION

- Provides improved product delivery (implement fixes)
- Enables SOS users to gain ability needed to assist external users
- Provides time for select external users to perform a system review and submit feedback
- Provides additional time for software vendors to test the API and become certified software vendors
- Lobbying Directory can be produced within one (legacy) system

# NEW CAL-ACCESS IMPLEMENTATION TIMELINE







## INITIAL LOG-INTO THE NEW CAL-ACCESS

New and returning users must complete a registration process the first-time logging in starting June 30, 2021.

- > Responsible Officers for multiple entities only need to create one account.
- Filing entities can be linked to the one account, eliminating the need for individual filing entity passwords.
- > Ownership of the entities can be transferred to another registered user by submitting a linkage request.
- > Linkage gives permission for that user to access a filing entity's data.




#### CERTIFICATION OF THE SYSTEM

- CAL-ACCESS system certification is targeted for the date of external implementation (June 2021).
- The new CAL-ACCESS becomes the "system of record" at the time of external implementation and certification (June 2021).
- SOS created a Certification Checklist being used by the project.
- There is a parallel activity for certification of software vendors.
