**REQUEST FOR HEARING  
ON REGISTERED CONVENTION ORDER**

I request a hearing to object to registration of the support order in this case, because:  
[Check all that apply.]

- Recognition and enforcement of the order is manifestly incompatible with (goes against) public policy. The issuing tribunal (the court that did the support order) did not use minimum standards of due process, which include notice and an opportunity to be heard.

- The order is not enforceable in the country where it was ordered.
- The order was obtained by fraud in connection with a procedural matter.

- There is already an Alaska court case about support between me and the other party. That case is open, and it was filed before this one.
- The order is incompatible with a more recent support order involving the same parties and having the same purpose, if the more recent support order is entitled to recognition and enforcement under this chapter in this state. [Check this box if there is a newer support order between you and the other party, the newer order conflicts with the order to be registered in this case, **and** this newer order would be enforceable in Alaska if it were registered.]
- I paid all or part of the arrears (unpaid back support) that the request alleges I owe.
- I did not appear in court and I was not represented by a lawyer in the foreign country that issued the support order, **and**
  - The law of that country requires that I get prior notice about the proceeding, but I did not get proper notice and a chance to be heard, **or**
  - The law of that country does **not** require that I get prior notice about the proceeding, I did not get proper notice of the support order, and I did not have a chance to challenge or appeal the order before a tribunal (a court).
