LIVE**STRONG** at the YMCA is the YMCA's free support program for cancer survivors, By giving cancer survivors and their families personalized guidance, small-group support, and wellness resources, this program empowers individuals from all walks of life to live their best lives possible after their courageous fights. Patricia's Story:

Patricia joined the program at age 51, even though she had 100s on individuals and their families completed the 12-week been cancer-free since 11. At the time, the treatments were dangerous and left her with painful side effects. Because of you, professional Y staff and fellow cancer survivors welcomed Patricia into the program, giving her the love and nurturing support she needed to get active and reclaim her health in spirit, mind, and body.

Even after visiting her doctor and discovering that she had heart failure caused by the high chemo dosage from her early cancer treatments, her LIVE**STRONG** at the YMCA family stood by her so that she could recover from this new challenge. You and the hundreds of other generous individuals who stand with the Y are why Patricia is now thriving. In one year, she lost 70 pounds, cured her prediabetes, and stopped her medication.



Mike lived in a rental unit in York City when a fire consumed their home and forced them into the streets. With nowhere else to go, they turned to the YMCA and connected with our staff.

Within hours, they were given access to an open room in the neighborhood free of charge and given toiletries, bedding, clothes, and food. while they repaired their unit.

Mike eventually returned to his old home, but not before becoming a part of the YMCA family, who will always be there for him when times are tough!
