

#### Significant changes during the year

- 1000 copies of the Volunteer guide are printed
- Approved Volunteer Policy and Youth Policy
- 72 trainees were trained in the program "On promoting the culture of non-violence and peace" ("YABC") and "Conflict Prevention and Resolution"
- A uniform documentary base for working with volunteers has been formed
- There are currently 363 members of the Volunteer Association (11.55% of the total number of members of the Society)







Due to funding constraints, regular work on the "Program for the restoration of family and consular communications for irregular migrants" in two short-term temporary stay places of foreigners and stateless persons (PTPI Chop and Mukacheve) of the State Border Guard Service of Ukraine was restored from April 2018.

462 conversations with detainees there




363 migrants phone calls to relatives for restoring family links






