- DECLARED CANCER FREE IN JUNE 2002 AND PURCHASED CAROLINA PANTHERS PSL'S TO CELEBRATE
- DIAGNOSED FOR A SECOND TIME IN AUGUST 2010
- TREATED WITH RECONSTRUCTIVE SURGERY AND CHEMOTHERAPY
- SINCE BEING DIAGNOSED IN 1999, HONOREE HAS VOLUNTEERED WITH NUMEROUS CANCER WALKS AND FUNDRAISERS; RAISED OVER \$75,000 FOR THE CURE AND VOLUNTEERS TIME COUNSELING THOSE BATTLING CANCER
