


BASED ON PRELIMINARY REPORTS FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY AGENCIES, TRAVEL DURING JUNE 1987 ON ALL ROADS AND STREETS IN THE NATION INCREASED BY 3.7 PERCENT AS COMPARED TO JUNE 1986, RESULTING IN ESTIMATED TRAVEL FOR THE MONTH AT 171930 MILLION VEHICLE MILES. THIS TOTAL INCLUDES 71847 MILLION VEHICLE MILES ON RURAL ROADS AND 100083 MILLION VEHICLE MILES ON URBAN ROADS AND STREETS.



TRAFFIC VOLUME TRENDS IS A MONTHLY REPORT BASED ON HOURLY TRAFFIC COUNT DATA. THESE DATA, COLLECTED AT APPROXIMATELY 4000 CONTINUOUS TRAFFIC COUNTING LOCATIONS NATIONWIDE, ARE USED TO DETERMINE THE PERCENT CHANGE IN TRAFFIC FOR THE CURRENT MONTH COMPARED TO THE SAME MONTH IN THE PREVIOUS YEAR. THIS PERCENT CHANGE IS APPLIED TO THE TRAVEL FOR THE SAME PERIOD IN THE PREVIOUS YEAR TO OBTAIN TRAVEL FOR THE CURRENT PERIOD.


