SELECTED HIGHWAY STATISTICS AND CHARTS -- 1993

MOTOR FUEL - 1993 Highway Use of Motor Fuel Totaled 137.2 Billion Gallons

In 1994, highway use of motor fuel is expected to increase by 2.4 percent to 140.6 billion gallons. Net State motor-fuel tax receipts increased by 4.1 percent from 1992. State motor-fuel tax revenues are expected to increase 1.9 percent in 1994.

The gasoline tax rate changed in 15 States in 1993. Eleven of the changes were the result of legislated tax increases. The others changed as a result of variable rate taxes. Variable rate taxes are adjusted based on changes in the wholesale price of gasoline, the consumer price index, or another indicator specified in the State tax law.

MOTOR-VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS - Total Motor-Vehicle Registrations Exceed 194 Million in 1993

Motor-vehicle registrations in the Nation increased from 190,362,228 in 1992 to 194,063,482 in 1993, an increase of 1.9 percent. Motor-vehicle and motor-carrier revenues increased 5.8 percent. Motor-vehicle registrations for 1994 are expected to exceed those in 1993 by 0.7 percent for a total of 195,469,000. Motor-vehicle and motor-carrier revenues are expected to increase by 1.2 percent in 1994.

DRIVER LICENSING - The Number of Licensed Drivers Increased to 173,149,313 in 1993

Although the middle-age group (age 40-44) still shows a large increase in drivers compared to 10 years ago (49 percent), the most drastic increase for the same period of time is still in the older drivers group (70 and over--53.9 percent).

HIGHWAY FINANCE - Total Highway Expenditures Increased by \$3.0 Billion in 1993

Revenues for highway purposes from motor-fuel taxes, motor-vehicle taxes and fees, and highway tolls increased by \$2.3 billion from 1992 to 1993. Those highway-user revenues totaled \$53.2 billion and accounted for 61.0 percent of total receipts for highways by all units of government in 1993. Total receipts for highways were \$87.3 billion, an increase of \$602 million over 1992. Revenues from general funds, property taxes, investment income and miscellaneous receipts--nonuser sources--totaled \$26.5 billion, approximately the same as in 1992. Bond proceeds for 1993 were \$7.6 billion, a decrease of \$1.7 billion from 1992.

Total highway expenditures by all units of government amounted to \$86.5 billion in 1993, up \$3.0 billion from 1992. Capital outlay increased by \$1.4 billion, or 3.7 percent, to \$39.7 billion. Inflation in 1993 highway construction prices caused real capital expenditures to increase by only 0.6 percent. Expenditures for highway maintenance and traffic services amounted to \$23.4 billion, an increase of \$1.1 billion, or 5.1 percent.

ROADWAY MILEAGE AND HIGHWAY TRAVEL - Travel Up 2.2 Percent

Public roads and streets in the United States, as of December 31, 1993, totaled approximately 3.90 million miles, an increase of 0.08 percent from 1992.

Highway travel in the United States increased to an estimated 2,297 billion vehicle-miles--an increase of about 2.2 percent from 1992.


The Interstate System accounts for about 1 percent of the Nation's total route mileage and carries 23 percent of the travel. The arterial highways (including Interstate) represent 11 percent of the mileage and carry 72 percent of the travel. All arterial and collector highways combined, which include 31 percent of the Nation's mileage, carry 87 percent of the travel.

MISCELLANEOUS - In 1993, expenditures per mile on State highways averaged \$33,120 and \$10,170 for capital outlay and maintenance, respectively. State highway-user revenue per 1,000 vehicle-miles of travel averaged \$19.00 for all States.



GASOHOL AS A PERCENT OF HIGHWAY USE OF GASOLINE - 1993




TOTAL MOTOR-VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS












HIGHWAY EXPENDITURES BY ALL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT









(EXCLUDING TOLL FACILITIES)**






STATE HIGHWAY-USER REVENUE PER VEHICLE MILE OF TRAVEL

² Section 1920 of the Energy Policy Act of 1992 expanded the definition of gasohol effective January 1, 1993. Prior to the Act, gasohol was defined as a blend of gasoline and at least 10 percent, by volume, fuel alcohol and blends containing less than 10 percent alcohol were taxed as gasoline. Under the Act, the product now called 10 percent gasohol corresponds to the old definition. Two additional types of gasohol are also defined. The term 7.7 percent gasohol includes gasoline-alcohol blends where the alcohol content is at least 7.7 percent but less than 10 percent. The term 5.7 percent gasohol includes gasoline-alcohol blends where the alcohol content is at least 5.7 percent but less than 7.7 percent.

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
