


Orange gradation: (from right to left) Powercat orange: PMS166C to Secondary orange: PMS144C





To insure the integrity of the Pacific Tigers logo, minimum size requirements have been established. Always follow these guidelines:

PACIFIC.

DO NOT reduce size to less than 1 ½ inches wide.

TIGERS

DO NOT reduce size to less than 1 1/4 inches wide.



DO NOT reduce size to less than 2 ½ inches wide.



DO NOT reduce size to less than ½ inches wide.



DO NOT reduce size to less than 7/8 inches wide.

The Pacific Tigers logo and all other components of the Pacific Tigers identity (such as color and typography) should be treated with a great deal of "visual respect." The following examples are a sampling of some possible misapplications of the logo. They should be avoided at all times. Special applications may be used in video or Internet animation.





DO NOT arrange the elements of any of the logos or logotypes in any way other than those described in this manual.





DO NOT alter the proportions of any of the logos or logotypes in any way other than those described in this manual.





DO NOT photomechanically alter any of the elements of any of the logos or logotypes.





DO NOT substitute any other typefaces for any of the official Pacific Tigers type or letterforms.

BASIC SIGNATURE STANDARDS

Unacceptable Variations







DO NOT place any of the logos or logotypes on a photograph or allow a photograph to show through any of the letters or shapes of any of the logos or logotypes.





DO NOT add any additional graphic devices to any of the logos or logotypes (such as outlines, drop-shadows, or 3-D effects).





DO NOT substitute any other colors for official Pacific Tigers colors or reverse the application of colors of any of the logos or logotypes.





DO NOT reproduce any element or elements of any of the logos or logotypes in a repeat pattern.





DO NOT eliminate any elements of any of the logos or logotypes except as described in this manual.
