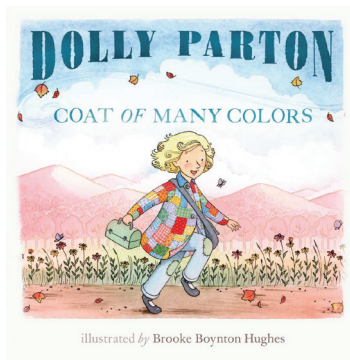
2016 ANNUAL REPORT

In 2016, the Canadian program mailed **186,350 books** across all age groups.

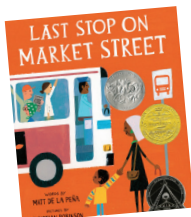

Royal National Institute of Blind People (RNIB) selected **6 titles for conversion** to braille and audio books for children in the United Kingdom who are blind or partially sighted.

In 2016, 57 new or revised titles were introduced to the Imagination Library lineup across the USA, Canada and United Kingdom including the 2016 Newbery Medal recipient **"Last Stop on Market Street"** by Matt de la Peña. Other notable new titles were **"Elmer"** by David McKee, **"Pom Pom Gets the Grumps"** by Sophy Henn and **"Great"** by Glen Gretzky and Lauri Holomis; Foreword by Wayne Gretzky.
