

Faculty Time Allotment Survey: Summary of Results

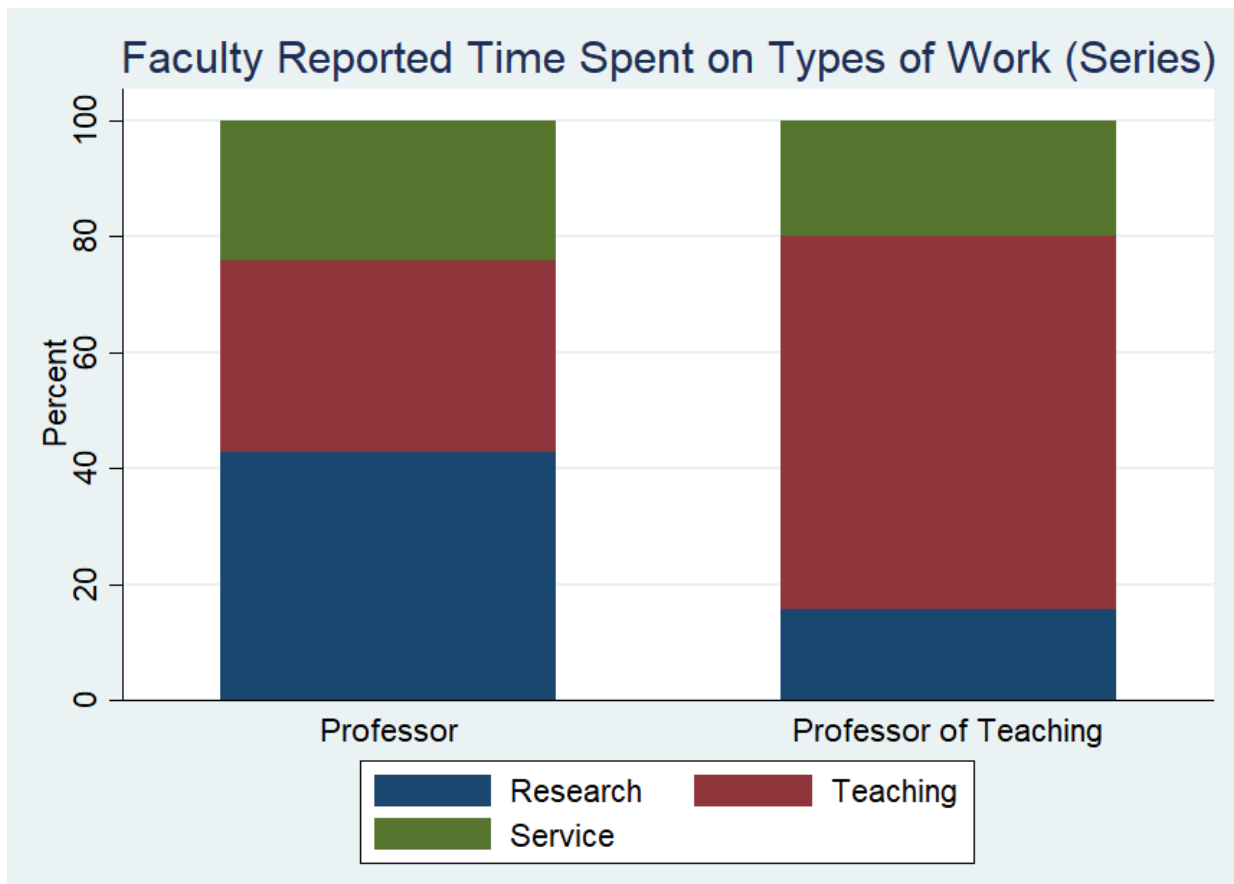
The short survey sent in winter quarter 2021 asked faculty (both Professors and Professors of Teaching) to indicate time spent on the three categories: teaching, research, and service. Another set of questions asked how much time faculty believed they were expected to spend in these same three categories. Finally, the survey included questions about course loads, department/school affiliations, rank, and other demographic information. Selected results are provided in the tables and charts below.

Actual Time vs. Expected Time: **Professor Series**

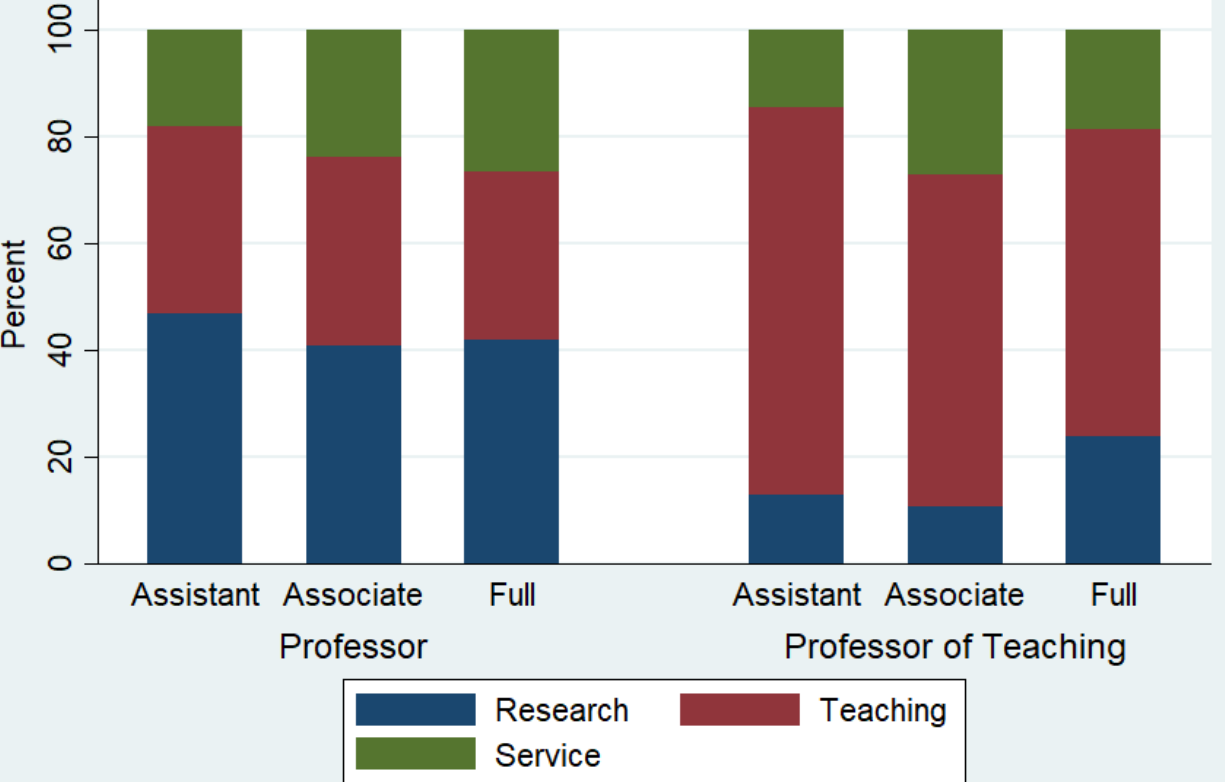
Activities	Actual Time	Expected Time

Actual Time vs. Expected Time: **Professor of Teaching Series**

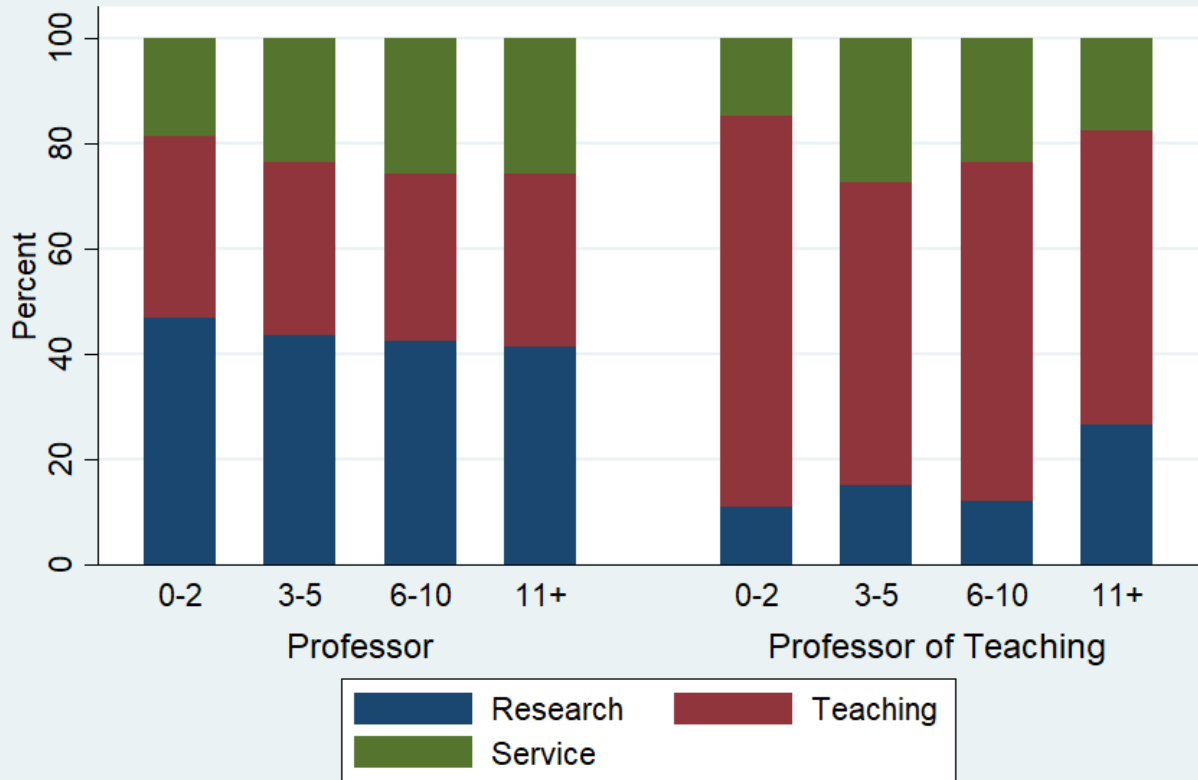
Activities	Actual Time	Expected Time

Service	19.8%	17.3%



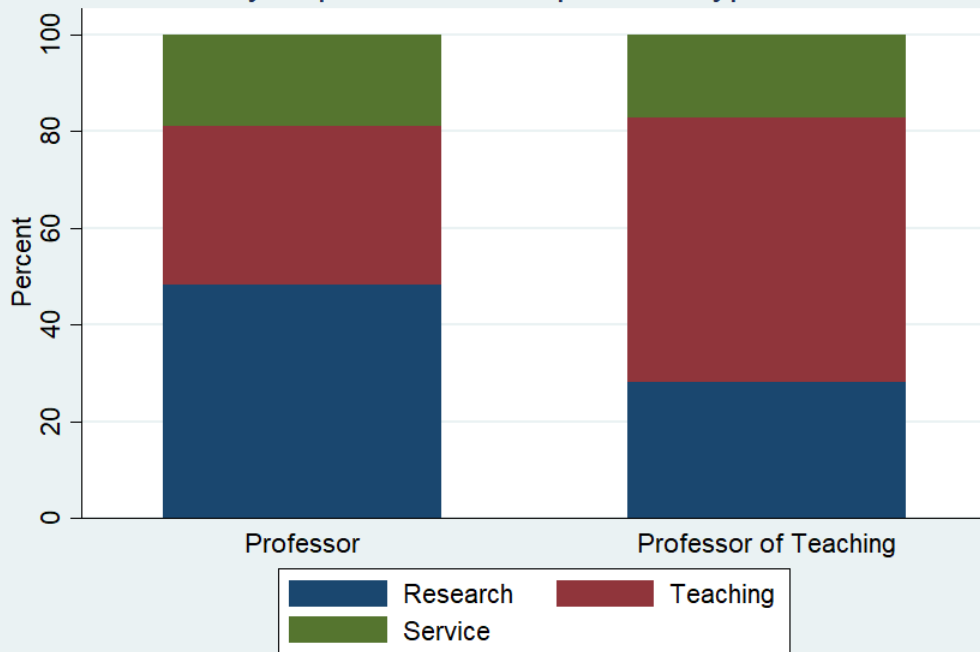
Faculty Reported Time Spent on Types of Work (Rank/Series)



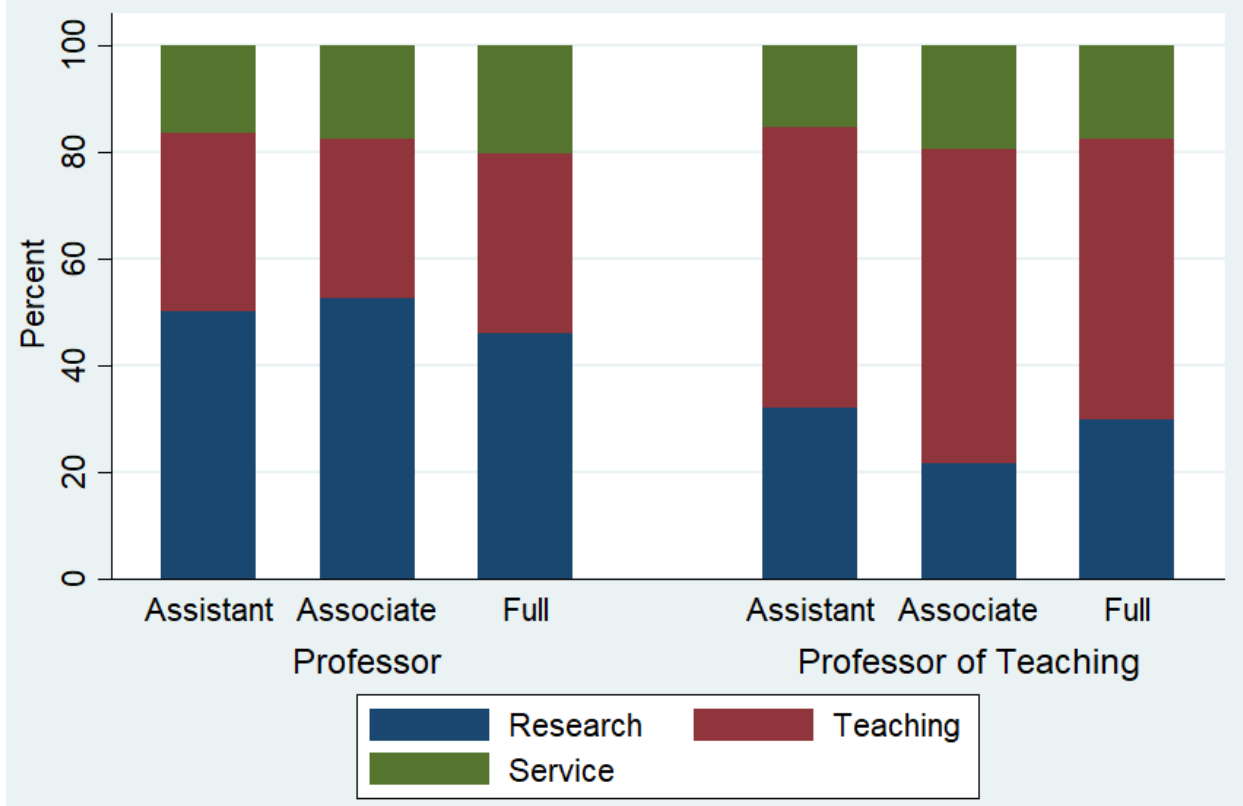
Faculty Reported Time Spent on Types of Work (Years/Series)
