### **ARIZONA**

#### Methodology

Interviews were conducted May 30-June 2, 2020 among a random sample of 1,002 Arizona voters contacted on landlines (233) and cellphones (769).

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of  $\pm 3$  percentage points.

Interviews were conducted by bilingual interviewers. Respondents were given the option of completing the interview in English or Spanish.

Telephone numbers were randomly selected from a statewide voter file of registered Arizona voters using a probability proportionate to size method, which means phone numbers are proportionally representative to the number of voters in all regions across the state.

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) (formerly known as Anderson Robbins Research) and Shaw & Company Research (R).

Fieldwork conducted by Braun Research, Inc. of Princeton, NJ.

Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted. An asterisk (\*) is used for percentages of less than one-half percent. A dash (-) represents a value of zero.

Some percentages may not add to 100% due to rounding. In the same way, percentages in "total" columns may be one point more or less than the sum of their parts due to rounding.
