# FOXNEWS POLL 

Questions 1-15, 24-41, and 48a are for release after 6PM/ET Wednesday, September 27, 2017. Questions 16-23 and 42-48 are for release after 6PM/ET Thursday, September 28, 2017.

## Methodology

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Anderson Robbins Research (D) and Shaw \& Company Research (R). The poll was conducted by telephone with live interviewers September 24-26, 2017 among a random national sample of 1,017 registered voters (RV).

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus three percentage points.

Landline (443) and cellphone (574) telephone numbers were randomly selected for inclusion in the survey using a probability proportionate to size method, which means phone numbers for each state are proportional to the number of voters in each state. Fieldwork conducted by Braun Research, Inc. of Princeton, NJ.

## Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted.

An asterisk (*) is used for percentages of less than one-half percent.
A dash (-) represents a value of zero.
Some percentages may not add to $100 \%$ due to rounding. In the same way, percentages in "total" columns may be one point more or less than the sum of their component parts due to rounding.
