INDIANA

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Anderson Robbins Research (D) and Shaw & Company Research (R). The poll was conducted by telephone with live interviewers September 29-October 2, 2018 among a random sample of 806 Indiana registered voters (RV).

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus 3.5 percentage points.

A subsample of 695 has been defined as likely voters (LV), with a margin of error of plus or minus 3.5 percentage points.

Landline (277) and cellphone (529) telephone numbers were randomly selected from a statewide voter file of registered Indiana voters using a probability proportionate to size method. This simply means phone numbers are proportionally representative to the number of voters in all regions across the state of Indiana. Voters who participated in one or more of the past five general elections (2008, 2010, 2012, 2014, 2016), plus new registrants since the 2016 election, were eligible for selection in the sample. Fieldwork by Braun Research, Inc. of Princeton, NJ.

An asterisk (*) is used for percentages of less than one-half percent.

A dash (-) represents a value of zero.

Some percentages may not add to 100% due to rounding. In the same way, percentages in “total” columns may be one point more or less than the sum of their component parts due to rounding.

Fox News Poll -- Margin of Error for Subgroups

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Anderson Robbins Research (D) and Shaw & Company Research (R). The poll was conducted September 29-October 2, 2018 by telephone (landline and cellphone) with live interviewers among a random sample of 806 Indiana registered voters. A subsample of 695 has been defined as likely voters. The margin of sampling error is plus or minus 3.5 percentage points for results among both registered and likely voters.
