## Methodology

Interviews were conducted January 20-22, 2019 among a random national sample of 1,008 registered voters (RV). Landline (315) and cellphone (693) numbers were randomly selected for inclusion in the survey using a probability proportionate to size method, which means telephone numbers for each state are proportional to the number of voters in each state.

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of  $\pm 3$  percentage points.

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) (formerly known as Anderson Robbins Research) and Shaw & Company Research (R).

*Note: In 2019, the firm Anderson Robbins Research changed its name to Beacon Research; the Fox News bipartisan polling team remains unchanged.*
