Questions 1-23, 30-43 and 48-51 are for release after 6PM/ET Wednesday, January 23, 2019. Questions 24-29 and 46-47 are for release after 6PM/ET Thursday, January 24, 2019. Questions 44-45 are for release after 6PM/ET Wednesday, January 30, 2019.

Methodology

Interviews were conducted January 20-22, 2019 among a random national sample of 1,008 registered voters (RV). Landline (315) and cellphone (693) numbers were randomly selected for inclusion in the survey using a probability proportionate to size method, which means telephone numbers for each state are proportional to the number of voters in each state.

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of ± 3 percentage points.

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) (formerly known as Anderson Robbins Research) and Shaw & Company Research (R).

Note: In 2019, the firm Anderson Robbins Research changed its name to Beacon Research; the Fox News bipartisan polling team remains unchanged.

Fieldwork conducted by Braun Research, Inc. of Princeton, NJ. Fox News Polls before 2011 were conducted by Opinion Dynamics Corporation.

Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted.
