Questions 1-16, 25-37, 44-48 \& 54-56 are for release after 6PM/ET Wednesday, July 24, 2019. Questions 17-24 \& 38-43 are for release after 6PM/ET Thursday, July 25, 2019. Questions 49-53 are for release after 6PM/ET Monday, July 29, 2019.

## Methodology

Interviews were conducted July 21-23, 2019 among a random national sample of 1,004 registered voters (RV). Landline (217) and cellphone (787) telephone numbers were randomly selected for inclusion in the survey using a probability proportionate to size method, which means phone numbers for each state are proportional to the number of voters in each state.

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $\pm 3$ percentage points.
The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) (formerly known as Anderson Robbins Research) and Shaw \& Company Research (R).
Note: In 2019, the firm Anderson Robbins Research changed its name to Beacon Research; the Fox News bipartisan polling team remains unchanged.
