#### NORTH DAKOTA

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Anderson Robbins Research (D) and Shaw & Company Research (R). The poll was conducted by telephone with live interviewers September 29-October 2, 2018 among a random sample of 801 North Dakota eligible voters (ALL). Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus 3.5 percentage points.

A subsample of 704 has been defined as likely voters (LV), with a margin of error of plus or minus 3.5 percentage points.

Landline (279) and cellphone (522) telephone numbers were randomly selected for inclusion in the survey using a probability proportionate to size method, which means phone numbers are proportionally representative to the number of voters in all regions across the state of North Dakota. Fieldwork conducted by Braun Research, Inc. of Princeton, NJ.

An asterisk (\*) is used for percentages of less than one-half percent. A dash (-) represents a value of zero.

Some percentages may not add to 100% due to rounding. In the same way, percentages in "total" columns may be one point more or less than the sum of their component parts due to rounding.
