NORTH DAKOTA

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Anderson Robbins Research (D) and Shaw & Company Research (R). The poll was conducted by telephone with live interviewers September 8-11, 2018 among a random sample of 804 North Dakota eligible voters (ALL).

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus 3.5 percentage points.

A subsample of 701 has been defined as likely voters (LV), with a margin of error of plus or minus 3.5 percentage points.

Landline (275) and cellphone (529) telephone numbers were randomly selected for inclusion in the survey using a probability proportionate to size method, which means phone numbers are proportionally representative to the number of voters in all regions across the state of North Dakota. Fieldwork conducted by Braun Research, Inc. of Princeton, NJ.

An asterisk (*) is used for percentages of less than one-half percent.

A dash (-) represents a value of zero.

Some percentages may not add to 100% due to rounding. In the same way, percentages in “total” columns may be one point more or less than the sum of their component parts due to rounding.

Results from Fox News polls before February 2011 were conducted by Opinion Dynamics Corp.

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Anderson Robbins Research (D) and Shaw & Company Research (R). The poll was conducted September 8-11, 2018 by telephone (landline and cellphone) with live interviewers among a random sample of 804 North Dakota eligible voters. A subsample of 701 has been defined as likely voters. The margin of sampling error is plus or minus 3.5 percentage points for results among both all eligible and likely voters.
