#### Abstract

ALABAMA

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Anderson Robbins Research (D) and Shaw \& Company Research (R). The poll was conducted by telephone with live interviewers November 13-15, 2017 among a random sample of 823 Alabama registered voters (RV).

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus 3 percentage points.

A subsample of 649 has been defined as likely voters (LV), with a margin of error of plus or minus 3.5 percentage points.

Landline (445) and cellphone (378) telephone numbers were randomly selected from a statewide voter file of registered Alabama voters using a probability proportionate to size method. This simply means phone numbers are proportionally representative to the number of voters in all regions across the state of Alabama. Fieldwork conducted by Braun Research, Inc. of Princeton, NJ.

\section*{Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted.}

An asterisk (*) is used for percentages of less than one-half percent. A dash (-) represents a value of zero. Some percentages may not add to $100 \%$ due to rounding. In the same way, percentages in "total" columns may be one point more or less than the sum of their component parts due to rounding.

## Fox News Poll -- Margin of Error for Subgroups

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Anderson Robbins Research (D) and Shaw \& Company Research (R). The poll was conducted by telephone with live interviewers November 13-15, 2017 among a random sample of 823 Alabama registered voters and a subsample of 649 likely voters. The margin of sampling error is plus or minus 3 percentage points for results among registered voters and 3.5 among likely voters.
