NEVADA

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Anderson Robbins Research (D) and Shaw & Company Research (R). The poll was conducted by telephone with live interviewers September 18-20, 2016 among a random sample of 805 Nevada registered voters (RV).

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus 3.5 percentage points.

A subsample of 704 has been defined as likely voters (LV) (plus or minus 3.5 percentage points).

Landline (383) and cellphone (422) telephone numbers were randomly selected from a statewide voter file of registered Nevada voters using a probability proportionate to size method. This simply means phone numbers are proportionally representative to the number of voters in all regions across the state of Nevada. Fieldwork conducted by Braun Research, Inc. of Princeton, NJ.

Interviews were conducted by bilingual interviewers. Respondents were given the option of completing the interview in English or Spanish.

Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted.

An asterisk (*) is used for percentages of less than one-half percent. A dash (-) represents a value of zero. Some percentages may not add to 100% due to rounding.
