# FOXNEWS POLL 

Questions 1-7 and 25-26 are for release after 6:00 PM/ET Friday, October 30, 2020. Questions 8-24, 27 are for release after 9:00AM/ET Sunday, November 1, 2020.

## Methodology

Interviews were conducted October 27-29, 2020 among a random national sample of 1,318 registered voters (RV). Landline (299) and cellphone $(1,019)$ telephone numbers were randomly selected for inclusion in the survey using a probability proportionate to size method, which means phone numbers for each state are proportional to the number of voters in each state.

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $\pm 2.5$ percentage points.
A subsample of 1,246 has been defined as likely voters (LV), with a margin of error of $\pm 2.5$ percentage points.

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) (formerly known as Anderson Robbins Research) and Shaw \& Company Research (R).

Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted.
