Questions 1-9, 12-29, 32-48 are for release after 6:00 PM/ET Wednesday, August 11, 2021. Questions 10-11, 30-31, 49-50 are for release after 6:00 PM/ET Thursday, August 12, 2021. Questions 51-58 are for release after 6:00 PM/ET Wednesday, September 8, 2021.

## Methodology

Conducted August 7-10, 2021, this Fox News Poll includes interviews among 1,002 registered voters (RV) nationwide who were randomly selected from a national voter file and spoke with live interviewers. Landline (149) and cellphone (853) telephone numbers were selected for inclusion using a probability proportionate to size method, which means phone numbers for each state are proportional to the number of voters in each state.

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $\pm 3$ percentage points.
The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) (formerly known as Anderson Robbins Research) and Shaw \& Company Research (R).

Fox News Polls before 2011 were conducted by Opinion Dynamics Corporation.

Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted.
